Introduction

This release guide documents release 8.7 of Banner® Web General. Release 8.7 includes enhancements and defects since release 8.6.2.

Change Request Enhancements

The following enhancement was addressed in Banner Web General 8.7:

- CR-000111533 (General) and CR-000112251 (Web General)

CR-000111533 (General) and CR-000112251 (Web General) - User defined roles for address, phone and email in SSB access



Note: This enhancement consists of both a General as well as a Web General enhancement. Though both General and Web General can be installed separately, you have to install both in order for this functionality to be available.

A new option has been added using the Business Rules Form (GORRSQL) rules to control the telephone and email types that are available for insert/update within Self-Service Banner (SSB). These new rules allow you to identify which telephone and email types should not be available for insert/update controllable by the SSB role (e.g. Student, Faculty, Employee).

The Address Role Privileges Form (GOAADRL) has been enhanced to allow greater control over the ability to update the address information. Also, the GTVSDAX entry `SSB_RULES / ADDRESS` expands the roles that can be used.

Sample rules that enable the control of telephone types that can be inserted into Self-Service Banner can be found in the GORRSQL rules under the `SSB_TELEPHONE_UPDATE` process and rule. Sample rules that enable the control of email types that can be inserted in SSB can be found in the GORRSQL rules under process and rule `SSB_EMAIL_UPDATE`. Each sample seed data rule has been delivered as inactive and not validated. Therefore, any current processing at your institution is not affected.

If no active rules are found, then all the telephone and email types defined in GTVEMAL/GOREMAL are eligible for inserting /updating into SSB based upon their current rules. Once a rule returns either a *Y* or an *N*, then no more rules are checked for that specific telephone and email type. Therefore, the most specific rules should be first, followed by the more generic ones.

You can use any, all, or none of the following bind variables in your SELECT statements:

- PIDM, EMAIL_TYPE (EMAIL_TYPE is a value from GTVEMAL for which you are setting up rules)
- ROLE_ALUMNI, ROLE_BSAC, ROLE_EMPLOYEE, ROLE_FACULTY, ROLE_FINAID, ROLE_FINANCE, ROLE_FRIEND, ROLE_STUDENT



Note: The ROLE_XXX variables will either be Y or N depending upon the role of the SSB user.

In order to insert a telephone or email type in SSB, at least one rule must return a Y for that telephone or email type to become available in the drop down selection box - assuming at least one rule is active.

Additionally, on the Update E-mail page, if an email type is not available for update, the entry will display, but the value from the `bwgkoadr.P_SelectEmailUpdate / QUERY_ONLY INFOTEXT` entry `Non Updateable` for example, will be appended to the email description.
